



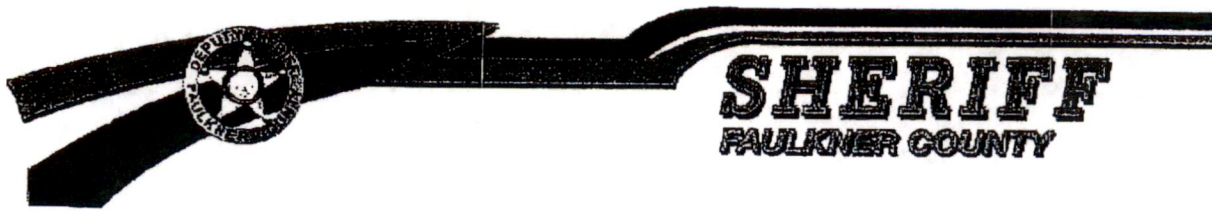

NARRATIVE

On April 11th 2022, Transport Deputy James Harrison was traveling on South German Lane when his issued unit, 1908, became stranded in the high water over the roadway not far from the Justice Building. Tornadic weather had struck Faulkner County that night reducing his and other driver's visibility. Pro Auto towed the unit to their impound lot and stated on 5/20/2022 that it had sustained flood damage to the interior and the motor was water locked. I forwarded the information to the Association of Arkansas Counties Risk Management.



On April 11th of this year 2022, I was at the justice building preparing to leave for the day when the weather got really bad. It had been stormy weather for the most part of the day with frequent tornado watches and warning going out. I tried to stay at work until my shift was over at 2030 hrs but my concern for the safety of my family grew as a tornado was spotted not too far from home.

At approximately 1900hrs I went to my vehicle and started it up when it began to hail golf ball or bigger sized chunks, this seemed to go on forever. I began to look around for somewhere to safely take the vehicle but there was nowhere to go and the sound was deafening. I waited awhile for it to stop then pulled out of the parking lot heading south on S German lane toward Dave Ward. When I got past the Justice Building the bottom fell out again with rain, wind and more hail. I attempted to pull over but couldn't see anything at all through the windshield, I was able to see headlights behind me and there were three other cars following. I pulled slightly right and slowed down to almost a stop when I felt some resistance, I wasn't moving. Thinking I was stuck I gave the car a little gas but it still wouldn't move, then it died. At first I didn't know it had cut out because of how loud the hail and rain was coming down and with dispatch talking over the radio. I tried to start it up two maybe three times but it wouldn't start.

My first call was to dispatch at 1938 but they said they wouldn't be able to help me so I called my supervisor, Sergeant Mize at 1940. He called his supervisor who tried to call the Captain but he was unavailable, and nobody knew what to do. I asked Dispatch about a tow truck but they asked if I could call a wrecker instead of them cause they had 16 calls backed up, so I did. Over the radio I heard dispatch say that there were two confirmed tornados that touched down in Mayflower so I knew I needed to get to the jail where it was safe. While making phone calls and gathering sensitive documents in the vehicle, water was coming in through the bottom of all the doors and before I knew it there was about three inches of water in the floor board. Everyone a large lifted vehicle would come by and the car would slosh around like I was just floating. I opened the door and water came rushing in, when I stepped out the water came up to my knees and I noticed that I was in the exit to the donut shop. All of the curbs and grass were covered with water all the way up to the car wash where people had taken refuge in the self wash stalls which looked like an island. The hail had stopped and there was a guy in a lifted truck pulling cars out of the flooded area, he pulled two cars and there were still a few behind me. Cars just kept driving into the flooded area. I told dispatch somebody needed to be blocking the road cause it was so flooded, there was a Conway P.D Officer for about 10 mins until they called out for help in Mayflower.

I began to walk back to the jail but a young man in a lifted truck asked if I needed a ride, so I put all my documents and folders in his truck and road on his tailgate to the jail. I noticed their lights were off so I went in to offer my assistance while waiting for the tow truck. I believe an hour or so had gone by and Officer Humphrey offered to come pick me up but had to navigate around other flooded parts of the city. We both drove back to my unit where the water had receded and there were vehicles littering the area, shortly after arriving the tow truck showed up to take it to Pro Auto.

After I made it home the weather service put out a flash flood warning which in my opinion was a little too late. I would have never thought that road would have been flooded as did all the other drivers I briefly spoke with. This is all I have to report at this time.
