Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas, an Ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION, MAINTENANCE OR CONFINEMENT OF INNATELY WILD, NON-DOMESTIC ANIMALS; NON-HUMAN PRIMATES; AND VENOMOUS REPTILES, WITHIN FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS; PROVIDING EXEMPTIONS FROM SUCH PROHIBITION; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION HEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the possession, maintenance or confinement of innately wild, non-domestic animals, non-human primates, and venomous reptiles presents an imminent threat to the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Faulkner County; and

WHEREAS, the possession, maintenance or confinement of innately wild, non-domestic animals, non-human primates, and venomous reptiles in Faulkner County is inconsistent with the public welfare of its citizens because of the dramatic growth in population and urbanization of Faulkner County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF FAULKNER, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: DEFINITIONS:

A: Except as provided herein, the term "innately wild, non-domestic animals" shall include but not be limited to the following families of the order of CARNIVORA:

(1) Ursidae: bears;

(2) Canidae: wolves;

(3) Hyaendae: hyenas; and

(4) Felidae: lions, tigers, leopards, American lions (commonly known as pumas, cougars, and panthers), cheetahs, bobcats, ocelots, jaguars, African panthers, lynx, and margays.

The term "innately wild, non-domestic animals" shall not include domestic breeds of dogs, cats, ferrets, raccoons and skunks.

- B: The term "non-human primates" shall include but not be limited to the following families:
 - (1) Monkeys: spider monkeys, squirrel monkeys, marmosets, baboons and relatives; and
 - (2) Great Apes: gorillas, orangutans, gibbons, siamangs, chimpanzees and relatives.
- C: The term "venomous reptiles" shall include but not be limited to the following families:
 - (1) Colubridae (two genera only), Dispholidus (boom slang) and Thelotornis (twig snake);
 - (2) Elapidae: cobras, kraits, coral snakes and relatives;
 - (3) Hydrophidae: sea snakes;
 - (4) Viperdae: vipers and adders;
 - (5) Crotalidae: pit vipers (commonly known as rattlesnakes, water moccasins and copperheads); and
 - (6) Helodermatidae: Gila monsters.
- Section 2: POSSESSION, MAINTENANCE OR CONFINEMENT OF INNATELY WILD, NON-DOMESTIC ANIMALS, NON-HUMAN PRIMATES, AND VENOMOUS REPTILES PROHIBITED.

Except as provided herein, the possession, maintenance or confinement of innately wild, non-domestic animals, non-human primates and venomous reptiles within Faulkner County is hereby prohibited.

Section 3: EXCEPTIONS:

- A. Non-human primates weighing less than twenty-five (25) pounds may be possessed, maintained or confined within Faulkner County, provided the owner or custodian thereof fully complies with the terms and conditions of Section 4 hereof.
- B. The prohibition stated in Section 2 hereof shall not apply to any bona fide circus, nor shall it apply to any federal research facility as these terms are defined in 9 C.F.R. sec. 1.1 (1999).

Section 4: PERMIT, INSPECTION AND CONDITIONS:

A. The owners and custodians of innately wild, non-domestic animals and non-human primates permitted to be possessed, maintained or confined within Faulkner County by Section 3 hereof shall obtain a permit from the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department allowing such possession, maintenance or confinement of such animal for a 12-month period. The

permit shall be renewed at the end of each 12-month period during the time that said animal is being kept or confined within Faulkner County. The cost of the initial permit, and each 12-month renewal permit, shall be \$100.00. Proof of insurance shall be provided to the Faulkner County Sheriff's before a permit is issued and shall be kept on file in the Sheriff's Office.

- B. The premises where the innately wild, non-domestic animal or non-human primate permitted by Section 3 hereof is being kept and confined within Faulkner County shall be annually inspected by the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department for compliance with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance. The annual inspection fee to be charged by the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department shall be \$100.00.
- C. The owners and custodians of innately wild, non-domestic animals and non-human primates permitted to be kept and confined in Faulkner County by Section 3 hereof shall abide by all health regulations that apply to the animal, such as shots and vaccinations, shall fully comply with provisions of 9 C.F.R. Sub. Sec. 3.125 through 3.133 (1999).
- D. Each owner or custodian of an innately wild, non-domestic animal or non-human primates be permitted to be kept and confined within Faulkner County by Section 3 hereof shall obtain liability or other insurance in the face amount not less than \$100,000.00 per person and \$300,000.00 per occurrence, protecting members of the public from personal injuries caused by the innately wild, non-domestic animals or non-human primates in their possession, care and custody.

Section 5: PENALTIES:

- A: Any person, firm or corporation possessing, maintaining or confining innately wild, non-domestic animals, non-human primates or venomous reptiles in Faulkner County in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00. It is hereby provided that each additional day of possessing, maintaining or confining said animal shall constitute an additional and separate violation of this Ordinance, punishable by the aforementioned penalty.
- B: There shall be a 30-day grace period for removal of the innately wild, non-domestic animal, non-human primate or venomous reptile from Faulkner County before said penalty shall be imposed.
- C: The enforcement of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be the responsibility of the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department.

Section 6: SEVERABILITY:

A determination that any provision of this Ordinance is void or invalid shall not render the remaining provisions of this Ordinance void or invalid, but said remaining provision(s) shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7: REPEALER:

Ordinance 86-13 and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An Ordinance to amend and supplement Faulkner County Ordinance 99-12 (July 21, 1999).

Section 1: Subsection A of Section 3 of Ordinance 99-12 is hereby amended as follows:

- "A. Non-human primates weighting less than twenty-five (25) pounds may be possessed, maintained or confined within Faulkner County, provided the owner or custodian thereof fully complies with the terms and conditions of Section 4 hereof except the insurance requirements set forth in Subsection D of Section 4."
- Section 2: Section 3 of Ordinance 99-12 is hereby further amended by adding a new subsection C as follows:
 - "C. The Faulkner County Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized to grant a waiver from the prohibition stated in Section 2 hereof to an owner of an animal defined in Section 1 hereof as either innately wild, non-domestic animal or a non-human primate weighing more than twenty-five (25) pounds whenever the Faulkner county Sheriff's Department, in its discretion, determines that the possession, maintenance or confinement of the innately wild, nondomestic animal or non-human primate weighing more than twenty-five (25) pounds does not pose a serious and immediate threat to the health, safety or welfare of the residents of Faulkner County. If the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department grants such a waiver, the owner of the innately wild, non-domestic or nonhuman primate weighing more than twenty-five (25) pounds is subject to, and must comply with, the requirements and conditions set forth in Section 4 hereof."

Section 3: SEVERABILITY:

A determination that any provision of this Ordinance is void or invalid shall not render the remaining provisions of this Ordinance void or invalid, but said remaining provision(s) shall remain in full force and effect.

Military Arguments

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, State of Arkansas, Argardinance to be entitled. An appropriation ordinance to establish the annual operating budget for calendar year 2000.

Section 1: ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY REFERENCE. The annual budget for calendar year 2000 identified as "2000 Annual Budget, Faulkner County, Arkansas", dated December 28, 1999 is hereby adopted by reference. A copy of said budget shall be filed in the Office of the County Clerk and shall be available for inspection and copying by any person during normal business hours.

Section 2: NONRESTRICTED EXPENDITURE CATEGORIES. Expenditures of funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not be restricted to the line item expenditure codes comprising the four major categories of expenditures- Personal services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges and Capital Outlays, but shall be restricted to office/departmental expenditures except for funds appropriated for personal salaries and wages and related employee benefits. Personnel expenditures shall not exceed the dollar amounts, number of employees, and salary or wage rates specified in the annual budget or and amendment thereto.

Section 3: EXPENDITURE RESTRICTED TO SPECIFIED FUNDS. No. expenditure of appropriated funds shall be made from any fund other than the fund specified in the Ordinance, or an amendment thereto.

Section 4: TRANSFERS. Any transfer of monies between the various funds of the County or between the four major categories of expenditures - Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges, Capital Outlays - shall be made only with prior approval of the Faulkner County Quorum Court. Provided, however, all transfers budgeted for in the annual budget shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.



ORDINANCE NO. 99-24

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF FAULKNER STATE P 1:06 OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

> AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2%) SALES AND USE TAX FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS; PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO.



WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas (the "County") has determined that there is a great need for a stable source of revenue to assist the County in funding County roads and matters of criminal justice; and

WHEREAS, Title 26, Chapter 74, Subchapter 4 of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated (the "Authorizing Legislation") provides for the levy of a one-half of one percent (%%) county-wide sales and use tax in counties not having a county-wide one percent (1%) sales and use tax; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Authorizing Legislation, the collections of the sales and use tax are divided among the levying county and the municipalities therein that do not levy a local sales and use tax based upon population, with the proviso that in the event the county subsequently levies an additional sales and use tax, all municipalities shall share in the tax collections based upon population; and

WHEREAS, the County does not currently levy a one percent (1%) sales and use tax; and

WHEREAS, municipalities in the County are also in need of a stable source of revenue to assist in financing the general operations and other purposes of their municipal governments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas:

Under the authority of the Authorizing <u>Article 1</u>. Legislation, there is hereby levied a new one-half of one percent (%) tax on the gross receipts from the sale at retail within the County of all items which are subject to the Arkansas Gross Receipts Act of 1941, as amended (A.C.A. §§26-52-101, et seq.), and the imposition of a new excise (or use) tax on the storage, use, distribution or other consumption within the County of tangible personal property subject to the Arkansas Compensating Tax Act of 1949, as amended (A.C.A. §§26-53-101, et seq.), at a rate of onehalf of one percent (%%) of the sale price of the property or, in the case of leases or rentals, of the lease or rental price (collectively, the "Sales and Use Tax").

Article 2. The Sales and Use Tax shall be levied and collected only on the first \$2,500 of gross receipts, gross proceeds or sales price from each single transaction.

Article 3. After the charge (currently 3%) is deducted by the State Treasurer for the services of the State of Arkansas in collecting and distributing the collections of the Sales and Use Tax, the remaining collections of the Sales and Use Tax (the "Net Collections") shall be distributed to the County and the municipalities therein that do not levy a sales and use tax based on population as described in the Authorizing Legislation; provided, however, that if the County subsequently levies an additional sales and use tax, the Net Collections shall be distributed to the County and all municipalities therein based on population as described in the Authorizing Legislation.

Article 4. Net Collections of the Sales and Use Tax to be received by the municipalities in the County shall be used by the municipalities to assist in funding the general operations and other purposes of their respective governments. Each such municipality shall make the determination as to how its share of the Net Collections shall be expended from time to time.

Article 5. The County's share of the Net Collections of the Sales and Use Tax shall be used as follows: 50% for the County Road Department; and 50% for criminal justice purposes.

Article 6. The term "criminal justice" shall be broadly defined and shall include particularly, without limitation, one or any combination of the following: law enforcement and the apprehension, prosecution, probation, rehabilitation or detention of any criminals, accused defendants, suspects or juvenile detainees.

Article 7. This Ordinance shall not take effect until an election is held on the question of levying the Sales and Use Tax at which a majority of the electors voting on the question shall have approved the levy of the Sales and Use Tax.

- c. For the purposes of the Sales an Use Tax, a single transaction regarding sales of general construction materials and supplies to contractors, builders and other buyers and on which an aggregate sales (or use) tax figure has been reported and remitted to the State.
- d. When two or more items of major household appliances, commercial appliances, major equipment and machinery are sold, each individual unit shall be treated as a single transaction for the purpose of the Sales and Use Tax.
- e. For groceries, drug items, dry goods and other tangible personal property and/or services not otherwise expressly covered in this Article, a single transaction shall be deemed to be any single sale which is reflected on a single invoice, receipt or statement, on which an aggregate sales tax figure has been reported and remitted to the State of Arkansas.

Article 7. All ordinances and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY POP FAULKNES, STATE OF ARKANSAS; AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTIONNIM FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS ON THE QUESTION OF LEVYING A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (%) SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN FAULKNER COUNTY; DEFINING THE TERM "SINGLE TRANSACTION;" AND PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO.

WHEREAS, Faulkner County, Arkansas (the "County") has passed on December 28, 1999, Ordinance No. 99-24 providing for the levy of a one-half of one percent (%%) sales and use tax within the County (the "Sales and Use Tax"); and

WHEREAS, the Sales and Use Tax shall be levied and collected only on the first \$2,500 of gross receipts, gross proceeds or sales price from each single transaction; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to call a special election on the question of the levy of the Sales and Use Tax and to define the term "single transaction;"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas:

Article 1. That there be, and there is hereby called, a special election to be held on February 8, 2000, at which election there shall be submitted to the electors of the County the question of the levy of the Sales and Use Tax.

Article 2. That the question of levying the Sales and Use Tax shall be placed on the ballot for the election in substantially the following form:

Vote on measure by placing an "X" in the square opposite the measure either for or against:

0.5% SALES AND USE TAX

FOR adoption of a one-half percent (0.5%) local sales and use tax within Faulkner County, Arkansas	
AGAINST adoption of a one-half percent (0.5%) local sales and use tax within Faulkner County, Arkansas	

Collections of the sales and use tax remaining after deduction of the administrative charges of the State of Arkansas ("Net Collections") shall be distributed to the County and each municipality therein not levying a sales and use tax based upon population as determined by the State legislation authorizing the tax; provided, however, that in the event the County subsequently levies an additional sales and use tax, the Net Collections shall be distributed to the County and all municipalities therein based upon population. The net collections to be received by the municipalities shall be used by each municipality to assist in financing the operations and other purposes of its government as determined from time to time by its government. The net collections of the tax to be received by the County shall be used by the County as follows: 50% for the County Road Department; and 50% for criminal justice purposes.

Article 3. That the election shall be held and conducted and the vote canvassed and the results declared under the law and in the manner now provided for county elections and only qualified voters of the County shall have the right to vote at the election.

Article 4. A copy of this Ordinance shall be given to the Faulkner County Board of Election Commissioners so that the necessary election officials and supplies may be provided. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall also be provided to the Commissioner of Revenues of the State of Arkansas as soon as practical.

Article 5. The County Judge and County Clerk, for and on behalf of the County, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary to call and hold the special election as herein provided and, if the levy of the Sales and Use Tax is approved by the electors, to cause the Sales and Use Tax to be collected and to perform all acts of whatever nature necessary to carry out the authority conferred by this Ordinance.

Article 6. "Single transaction" is defined according to the nature of the goods purchased as follows:

- a. When two or more devices in which, upon which or by which any person or property is, or may be, transported or drawn, including but not limited to, on-road vehicles, whether required to be licensed or not, farm vehicles, off-road vehicles, airplanes, water vessels, motor vehicles, or non-motorized vehicles, and mobile homes, are sold to a person by a seller, each individual unit, whether part of a "fleet" sale or not, shall be treated as a single transaction for the purpose of the Sales and Use Tax.
- b. The charges for any utility services, which are subject to the Sales and Use Tax, and which are furnished on a continuous service basis, whether such services are paid daily,
