

An Ordinance to be entitled: An Ordinance granting to Friendship Cable of Arkansas, Inc. their successors and assigns, the right to erect, maintain and operate transmission and service distribution facilities and additions thereto, in, under, over, along, across and upon streets, lanes, avenues, alleys, bridges, highways and other public places in Faulkner County, Arkansas, not within the incorporated limits of any city as of this date, and subsequent additions thereto for the purpose of erecting, operating and maintaining a television antenna system and a television signal transmission system thereon and thereunder serving the inhabitants of said County, and for other purposes, for a period of ten (10) years, with the option to renew the same and regulating the same, for other purposes and to amend Faulkner County Ordinance 96-08 (June 19, 1996).

- Section 1: In consideration of the faithful performance and observance of the conditions and reservations hereafter specified, the right is hereby granted to Friendship Cable of Arkansas, Inc., their successors and assigns, hereinafter referred to as Grantee, to erect, maintain and operate antenna television transmission and distribution facilities in, under, over, along, across and upon the streets, lanes, avenues, sidewalks, alleys, bridges and other public places in Faulkner County, Arkansas, not within the incorporated limits of a city as of this date, and subsequent additions thereto, for the purpose of transmission and distribution of television impulses and television energy, both community antenna and closed circuit including programs, recorded on film and television tape or otherwise recorded in accordance with the laws and regulations of the United States of America and the State of Arkansas, for a period of ten (10) years with the option to renew the same for an additional ten years (10) years, upon the same terms and conditions herein provided for by giving written notice of the desire to do so at least one (1) year prior to the expiration here of, subject to the conditions thereof.
- Section 2: Whenever used in this Ordinance, the word "television" shall mean a system for simultaneous transmission of audio signals and visual images by means of electrical impulses.
- Section 3: This right-of-way for the use and purposes herein set forth shall not be exclusive but is merely a permit allowing Grantee to use the streets, alleys, etc., of Faulkner County, Arkansas, for the purpose herein set forth.

Section 4: The Grantee's transmission and distribution system, poles, wires and appurtenances shall be located, erected and maintained so as to not to endanger or interfere with the lives of persons, or to interfere with any improvements Faulkner County, Arkansas may deem proper to make, or to hinder unnecessarily or obstruct the free use of the streets, alleys, bridges or other public property.

Construction and maintenance of the transmission distribution system, including house connections, shall be in accordance with the provisions of the National Electrical Safety Code, prepared by the National Bureau of Standards, the National Electrical Code of the National Board of Fire Underwriters and such applicable Ordinances and regulations of Faulkner County, Arkansas, affecting electrical installations which may be presently in effect or may be enacted by the County.

Installation and house drop hardware shall be uniform throughout Faulkner County, except that Grantee shall be free to change Grantees hardware and installation procedure as improvements therein are developed and except where changes are permitted or required by regulations and Ordinances of Grantor presently in effect or which may be enacted hereafter.

Section 5: The Grantor shall have the right to prescribe reasonable service rules and regulations for the conduct of this business and service rules and regulations shall be kept on file at all times with the Faulkner County Clerk.

Section 6: The Grantee shall construct a system capable of providing twenty-four (24) or more channels of satisfactory television reception.

Section 7: The Grantee's distribution system shall conform to the requirements of the Federal Communications Commission, particularly with respect to freedom from spurious radiation.

Section 8: The antenna, receiving and distribution equipment shall be installed and maintained so as to provide pictures on subscriber receivers throughout the system essentially of the same quality as those received at the antenna site and/or transmitted by the Grantee.

Section 9: All provisions of law provided and prescribed for the granting of this permit and authority are hereby declared to have been fully complied with and the permit shall be in full force and effect from and after its execution and approval. The grantee shall pay annually, and in consideration of the granting of this permit and authority, agree to pay to Grantor, as a tax and as compensation for the right and privilege enjoyed hereunder, three percent (3%) of the annual gross proceeds received by the Grantee herein. Such annual period shall be deemed a calendar year and payments shall be due within ninety (90) days thereafter.

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An Ordinance authorizing the issuance of a promissory note to provide financing for a courts building and ancillary offices; and prescribing other matters pertaining thereto.

WHEREAS, Faulkner County, Arkansas (the "County") is authorized and empowered under the provisions of Amendment No. 78 to the Arkansas Constitution ("Amendment No. 78") and act No. 1808 of 2001 ("Act No. 1808"), to issue notes and to expend the proceeds thereof to finance the cost of acquiring and constructing real property or tangible personal property having an expected useful life of more than one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, the County proposes to acquire property adjacent to the County Courthouse grounds commonly known as the former First Presbyterian Church building and to remodel the building for use as a courts building with ancillary offices (the land and building to be referred to herein as the "Courts Building"); and

WHEREAS, it is proposed that the County issue its Promissory Note (Courts Building Project) in the principal amount of \$900,000.00 (the "Note") under Amendment No. 78 and the Authorizing Legislation for the purpose of financing all or a portion of the costs of the acquisition and remodeling of the Courts Building; and

WHEREAS, the County has made arrangements with Simmons First National Bank (the "Purchaser") to purchase the note;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, Arkansas:

ARTICLE 1: The Quorum Court hereby finds that the Courts Building will have a useful life of more than one (1) year, that the County has not heretofore incurred any obligations under Amendment No. 78 and that the principal amount of the Note does not exceed two and one-half percent (2.5%) of the assessed value of taxable property located within the County as determined by the last tax assessment.

ARTICLE 2: The issuance of the Note in the principal amount of \$900,000.00 is hereby authorized under Amendment No. 78 and Act No. 1808 in order to finance all or a portion of the cost of the acquisition and remodeling of the Courts Building and expenses of issuing and securing the Note. The Note shall be dated the date of issuance and shall bear interest on the outstanding principal amount at the rate of 5.00% per annum. The Note shall be repaid in five equal annual installments of the principal and interest, commencing one year from the date of the Note, with the final installment due five years from the date of the Note.

ARTICLE 3: The Note shall be sold to the Purchaser for the purchase price of 100% par.

ARTICLE 4: As provided in Amendment No. 78, the annual debt service payments on the Note in each fiscal year shall be charged against and paid from the general revenues of the County for such fiscal year. For the purpose of making the annual debt service payments, there is hereby, and shall be, appropriated to pay the Note, and amount of the general revenues of the County sufficient for such purposes. The County Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to withdraw from the General Fund of the County and/or from such other sources as may be hereafter directed by the Quorum Court, the amounts and at the times necessary to make the annual debt service payments on the Note.

ARTICLE 5: (a) The County covenants with the Purchaser that it shall not take any action or suffer or permit any action to be taken or condition to exist which causes or may cause the interest payable on the Note to be included in gross income for federal income tax purposes. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the County covenants with the Purchaser that the proceeds of the sale of the Note will not be used directly or indirectly in such manner as to cause the Note to be treated as an "arbitrage bond" within the meaning of Section 148 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code").

(b) The County covenants with the Purchaser that it will not use or permit the use of the Courts Building or the proceeds of the Note, in such manner as to cause the Note to be a "private activity bond" within the meaning of Section 141 of the Code. In this regard, the County covenants with the Purchaser that (i) it will not use (directly or indirectly) the proceeds of the Note to make or finance loans to any person, and (ii) that while the Note is outstanding the Courts Building will only be used by state and local governmental entities and by other persons on a basis as members of the general public.

(c) The Note is hereby designated as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" within the meaning of the Code. The County represents to the Purchaser that the aggregate principal amount of its qualified tax-exempt obligations (excluding "private activity bonds" within the meaning of Section 141 of the Code which are not "qualified 501(c)(3) bonds" within the meaning of section 145 of the Code), including those of its subordinate entities, issued in calendar year 2001 will not exceed \$10,000,000.00

(d) The County covenants with the Purchaser that will not reimburse itself from Note proceeds for any costs paid prior to the date the Note is issued except in compliance with United States Treasury Regulation No. 1.150-2 (the "Regulation"). This Ordinance is an "official intent" within the meaning of the Regulation.

- (e) The County covenants with the Purchaser that it will submit to the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States of the United States, not later than the 15th day of the second calendar month after the close of the calendar year quarter in which the Note which contains the information required by Section 149(e) of the Code.

ARTICLE 6: The Note shall be secured by a mortgage lien on the Courts Building and in order to evidence the lien, the County Judge and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to execute, acknowledge and deliver to the Purchaser a mortgage (the "Mortgage").

ARTICLE 7: The County Judge and County Clerk, for and on behalf of the County, are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary to effect the execution and delivery of thereunder, the issuance, execution, sale and delivery of the Note, and the performance of all acts of whatever nature necessary to effect and carry out the authority conferred by this Ordinance. The County Judge and County Clerk are hereby further authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the County, to execute all papers, documents, agreements, certificates and other instruments that may be required for the carrying out of such authority or to evidence the exercise thereof.

ARTICLE 8: The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable, and if any article, phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared to be invalid, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the articles, phrases and provisions.

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An appropriation ordinance to establish the annual operating budget for calendar year 2002.

Section 1: ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY REFERENCE. The annual budget for calendar year 2002 identified as "2002 Annual Budget, Faulkner County, Arkansas", dated December 27, 2001 is hereby adopted by reference. A copy of said budget shall be filed in the Office of the County Clerk and shall be available for inspection and copying by any person during normal business hours.

Section 2: NONRESTRICTED EXPENDITURE CATEGORIES. Expenditures of funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not be restricted to the line item expenditure codes comprising the four major categories of expenditures- Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges and Capitol Outlays, but shall be restricted to office/departmental expenditures.

Section 3: EXPENDITURE RESTRICTED TO SPECIFIED FUNDS. No expenditure of appropriated funds shall be made from any fund other than the fund specified in the Ordinance or an amendment thereto.

Section 4: TRANSFERS. Any transfer of monies between the various funds of the County or between the four major categories of expenditures – Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges, Capitol Outlays – shall be made only with prior approval of the Faulkner county Quorum Court. Provided, however, all transfers budgeted for in the annual budget shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.
