The museum shall be under the direct management and control of the Faulkner County museum commission, which shall consist of three (3), six (6) or nine (9) members to be appointed by the County Judge, subject to confirmation and approval of the Quorum Court. The size of the commission shall be determined by the Quorum Court in collaboration with the museum director and chair of the commission, and shall be made considering the size of the museum and the population of the county. Members previously appointed under prior law shall serve the remainder of their term. Successor members shall be appointed for three-year staggered terms and shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified. If any vacancy shall occur on the commission, the vacancy shall be filled by appointment for the un-expired portion of the term, in the same manner as provided for the initial appointment, as set out in A.C.A. 13-5-501 (b) (1). Members of the commission shall serve without pay. The commission shall elect one of its members as chair and shall also elect such officers as the commission may deem necessary.

ORDINANCE 04-27

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, State of Arkansas. An Ordinance to be entitled: An appropriation ordinance to establish the annual operating budget for calendar year 2005.

Section 1: ANNUAL BUDGET ADOPTED BY REFERENCE. The annual budget for calendar year 2005 identified as "2005 Annual Budget, Faulkner County, Arkansas", dated December 28, 2004 is hereby adopted by reference. A copy of said budget shall be filed in the Office of the County Clerk and shall be available for inspection and copying by any person during normal business hours.

Section 2: NONRESTRICTED EXPENDITURE CATEGORIES. Expenditures of funds appropriated by this Ordinance shall not be restricted to the line item expenditure codes comprising the four major categories of expenditures- Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges and Capital Outlays, but shall be restricted to office/departmental expenditures.

Section 3: EXPENDITURE RESTRICTED TO SPECIFIED FUNDS. No expenditure of appropriated funds shall be made from any fund other than the fund specified in the Ordinance or an amendment thereto.

Section 4: TRANSFERS. Any transfer of monies between the various funds of the County or between the four major categories of expenditures – Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges, Capital Outlays – shall be made only with prior approval of the Faulkner County Quorum Court. Provided, however, all transfers budgeted for in the annual budget shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.
