Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas, an Ordinance to be entitled: An Organizational Ordinance for the 2015-16 Faulkner County Quorum Court.

WHEREAS, Act 130 of 1975 of the Arkansas General Assembly requires the County Quorum Courts to meet monthly at a time and place specified by ordinance and authorizes the calling of special meetings.

Section 1: Regular Meeting

The regular monthly meeting of the Faulkner County Quorum Court shall be held at 7:00pm on the third Tuesday of each month in Courtroom "A" of the Faulkner County Courthouse .

If Courtroom "A" of the Faulkner County Courthouse is not available for a meeting, the Quorum Court shall hold its regular meeting at some other convenient location within the city of Conway as designated by the Faulkner County Judge.

Section 2: Special Meeting

Special meetings of the Faulkner County Quorum Court may be called by the County Judge or by a majority of the elected Justices of the Peace upon at least twenty-four (24) hours' notice.

Such notice shall include the time, date, and place of the special meeting; provided that the meeting shall not be held outside of the boundaries of Faulkner County. The notice shall also include the general purpose of the meeting.

Notice of a special meeting given at any regular or special meeting shall constitute due notice to the members present. The County Clerk shall be responsible for providing timely notice to absent members, as well giving public notice, containing the information listed above.

Notice of a special meeting called by the County Judge shall be accomplished by the County Judge notifying the County Clerk in writing, if time permits, who shall be responsible for notifying each Justice individually in writing, if time permits, and giving due public notice.

Notice of a special meeting called by a majority of the Justices shall be accomplished by one member notifying the County Clerk in writing, if time permits. Such notice shall also include the names of the each Justice making up the majority calling the meeting. The

County Clerk shall be responsible for notifying the County Judge and other Justices in writing, if time permits, and giving due public notice.

Section 3: Rescheduling a Regular Meeting

Regular meetings of the Faulkner County Quorum Court shall be rescheduled only by a resolution approved by a majority of the elected Justices of the Peace at a regular or special meeting or by a petition signed by a majority of the elected Justices of the Peace.

The resolution or petition shall include the time, date, and place of the rescheduled meeting; provided that the meeting shall not be held outside of the boundaries of Faulkner County.

Any petition rescheduling a regular meeting shall be delivered to the County Clerk at least twenty-four (24) hours before the regular or rescheduled meeting, whichever shall be the sooner.

Notice of a rescheduled meeting given at any regular or special meeting of the Quorum Court shall constitute due notice to the members present. The County Clerk shall be responsible for giving timely notice to absent members as well as giving public notice.

If a regular meeting of the Quorum Court is rescheduled by petition, the County Clerk is responsible for giving timely notice to the County Judge and the Justices of the Peace in writing, if time permits, as well as giving public notice.

Section 4: Secretariat

In accordance with A.C.A. § 14-14-902, the County Clerk or her designee is appointed as Secretariat of this Court. The duties of the Secretariat shall be as stated in A.C.A. 14-14-903(a)(3). She shall record all full court and committee meetings, with the exception of executive sessions.

Section 5: Legal Counsel

The County Civil Attorney is hereby designated as legal counsel for the Quorum Court pursuant to A.C.A. 14-14-903(b).

Section 5: Procedural Rules

Robert's Rules of Order are hereby designated as the controlling Rules of Procedure for all meetings of the Faulkner County Quorum Court, pursuant to A.C.A. 14-14-904(e).







Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of the County of Faulkner, State of Arkansas, An Ordinance to be entitled: An appropriation Ordinance to grant Sheriff's Department raises.

WHEREAS: the Quorum Court initially passed Ordinance No. 99-24 establishing a one-half of one percent (1%) sales tax, in 1999; and

WHEREAS: such tax was passed pursuant to Title 26, Chapter 74 of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated; and

WHEREAS: the Quorum Court on this date acknowledges that while an equal division of the revenue, between the County Road Department and Criminal Justice purposes, from such tax was appropriate in 1999, a different allocation is appropriate at this time; and

WHEREAS: the Quorum Court is charged with the responsibility to use tax revenues in the most efficient and responsible manner possible; and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court now, in order to raise the salaries of the employees of the Sheriff's Department, and provide funds to sustain such raises, finds a change in the indicated use of revenues derived from the sales and use tax passed in 1999 to 35 % for the County Road Department and 65% for Criminal Justice purposes to be necessary; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Article 1: Article 5 of Ordinance No. 99-24, is amended to state as follows: The County's share of the Net Collections of the Sales and Use Tax shall be used as follows: 35 % for the County Road Department, 65% for Criminal Justice purposes.

Article 2: This Ordinance shall not take effect until an election is held on the question of changing the indicated use of the Sales and Use Tax, at which a majority of the electors voting on the question shall have approved the designated change.

Article 3: Ordinance 14-30 is amended as follows:

Section 1: Definitions

Election official or election officer: means a person who is a member of the county board of election commissioners, a person who performs election coordinator duties, or a person who is a poll worker designated by a county board of election commissioners to be an election clerk, election judge, or election sheriff, or a deputy county clerk or a person assigned by a county clerk to conduct early voting

Logic and accuracy testing: means to proof the programming of the personalized electronic ballots (PEBs) and to test each precinct, each ballot style, and each contest position on the ballot.

Personalized electronic ballots (PEBs): is a component of the iVotronic Voting System which is used to create and contain computerized ballots.

Political party: means any group of voters that at the last preceding general election polled for its candidate for Governor in the state or nominees for presidential electors at least three percent (3%) of the entire vote cast for the office.

Poll worker: means an election judge, election sheriff, or election clerk.

Polling site: means a location selected by the county board of election commissioners where votes are cast.

Precinct: means the geographical boundary lines dividing a county, municipality, township, or school district for voting purposes.

Sample ballot: means a ballot for distribution to the public or the press marked with the word "SAMPLE" so as to prevent the production of counterfeit ballots.

Voting Machine: means either

- A. A direct recording electronic voting machine that:
 - a. Records votes by means of a ballot display provided with mechanical or electro-optical components that may be actuated by the voter;
 - b. Processes that data by means of a computer program;
 - c. Records voting data and ballot images in internal and external memory components; and
 - d. Produces a tabulation of the voting data stored in a removable memory component and on a printed copy; or
- B. An electronic device for marking a paper ballot to be electronically scanned.

Voting system: means the total combination of mechanical, electromechanical, or electronic equipment, including the software, firmware, and documentation required to program, control, and support the equipment that is used for the following:

- A. To define ballots;
- B. To cast and count votes;
- C. To report or display election results; and
- D. To maintain and produce any audit trail information

Section 2: Duties of the Faulkner County Election Coordinator

- A. The county election coordinator shall coordinate and assist the CBEC and county clerk in fulfilling their constitutional and statutory responsibilities in the preparation for and administration of Faulkner County elections.
- B. Perform all duties delegated or assigned to the county election coordinator by the CBEC, as a first priority, and the county clerk while under the supervision of the county clerk.
- C. Provide the CBEC and the county clerk with reports as required by law.
- D. Apply rules, procedures, and systems according to applicable laws to guide election personnel in the administration of county elections.
- E. Ensures security and maintenance of a large number of voting machines along with their personalized electronic ballots and keeps records of the allocation of the machines and accessories to each precinct.
- F. Responsible for the design and preparation of customized materials required for elections including ballot design, sample ballots, proofing and production, including identification of ballot jurisdictions and specifications.
- G. Responsible for directing and verifying accurate coding of elections in the computerized voting system that produces a memory pack containing all election data to assure accurate ballot tabulation for each polling location.
- H. Directs logic and accuracy testing of the personalized electronic ballots for candidates, media, and general public five days before each election.

- I. Selects and analyzes suitable polling sites ensuring location, parking and facility comply federal, state, and local requirements.
- J. Coordinates and conducts public hearings on updating districts and precincts and prepares the legal descriptions and maps required for county elections.
- K. Serves as the liaison with candidates, campaign personnel, media, and the general public concerning procedures, policies, and complaints.
- L. Develops a schedule of events for each election and ensures deadlines are met.
- M. Applies recruitment and training procedures for election officials; conducts training sessions and produces training manuals for election officials.
- N. Maintains record keeping methods and procedures for all election records and poll worker information.
- O. Interacts with various county officials, the State Board of Election Commissioners, the Secretary of State, officials of municipalities within the county, and school district officials regarding election rules and procedures.
- P. Coordinates with the county clerk and the CBEC in locating early voting satellite locations within the county, provides training for the early voting officials, and supervises the early voting process, insuring the security of all election materials and accuracy in voter registration records for the early voters.
- Q. Informs the CBEC and the county clerk on election preparation including ballot positioning for candidates, poll worker appointments, polling location changes, and voter problems including public forums on polling location problems; during post-election, coordinates meetings for certification of election contests, including recount if ordered.
- R. Meets with the CBEC and the County Clerk to keep them apprised of new election laws, how to implement new laws, procedures, planning election activities, and reviewing new equipment options.
- S. Perform other duties as assigned by the County Judge, County Clerk or as required by law.

Section 3: Compensation for the Faulkner County Election Coordinator

The county election coordinator shall be compensated in an amount to be determined by the Faulkner County Quorum Court.

Section 4: Hiring of the Faulkner County Election Coordinator

The county election coordinator shall be hired by the County Judge.

Section 5: Emergency Clause

An emergency is hereby declared pursuant to A.C.A. 14-14-908, in that an election is drawing near and the Coordinator is needed to prepare for it adequately.

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court of Faulkner County desires to facilitate each employee's ability to defend themselves when necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FAULKNER COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: Any Faulkner County employee or elected official who is licensed to carry a concealed handgun is hereby allowed to carry the type of weapon named on the license in accordance with Act 1259 of 2015, on county property as specified in Act 1259.

SECTION 2: The licensee is still prohibited from carrying a weapon in a detention facility, in an office of the Sheriff's Department, in the Faulkner County Justice Building, or in any courtroom without permission from the presiding judge.

SECTION 3: The licensee who chooses to carry a firearm pursuant to Act 1259 and this ordinance shall maintain possession of such firearm on their person or locked in a secure location at all times on county property.

SECTION 4: The language of Sections 1 through 3 of this ordinance shall be incorporated into the Faulkner County Personnel Manual and the County Security and Emergency Preparedness Plan upon passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY

Section 1. The Faulkner County Board of Election Commissioners has voted to establish Vote Centers in Faulkner County, rather than polling sites. A polling site can serve only its immediate vicinity, whereas any Faulkner County voter can vote at any Vote Center, thus serving the convenience of the voters as never before.

Section 2. Arkansas Code Annotated §7-5-101 requires the County Clerk to certify that "the county has a secure electronic connection sufficient to prevent: an elector from voting more than once; and unauthorized access to a computerized registration book maintained by the county clerk."

Section 3. Margaret Darter, the Faulkner County Clerk, has certified the required information to this Court, as attached as Exhibit A.



No expenditure of appropriated funds shall be made from any fund other than the fund specified in the Ordinance or an amendment thereto.

Section 4: TRANSFERS.

Any transfer of monies between the various funds of the County or between the four major categories of expenditures - Personal Services, Supplies, Other Services and Charges, Capital Outlays - shall be made only with prior approval of the Faulkner County Quorum Court. Provided, however, all transfers budgeted for in the annual budget shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.

Section 5: REPEALER.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or application of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

Section 6: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance is adopted to comply with the provisions of A.C.A. § 14-14-907 and shall be effective as of January 1, 2016.
