Bids will be accepted until **9:00 a.m., Monday, December 19, 2022** at which time the Bids will be opened and read in the County Judges office, 801 Locust Street, Conway Arkansas 72034. The successful contractor will receive notice within **7 days after the County Judge's approval.**

SPECIFICATIONS FOR ASPHALT & RELATED WORK
Asphalt to be January thru December 2023.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

1. The work includes placing asphalt surface course on various county roads in the Faulkner County along with other county asphalt paving work as designated by the County Judge or his designee that the Contractor is willing to include in the paving work.
2. One unit price per ton of asphalt will be submitted for all labor, equipment, and material necessary to produce and placement of the ACHM Surface Course PG 64-22 at an average of two inches thick on any county road in Faulkner County.
3. One unit price per ton of asphalt will be submitted for all labor, equipment and material necessary to produce and placement of the ACHM Binder Course PG 64-22 at an average of two and one half inches on any county road in Faulkner County.
4. One unit price per ton of asphalt will be submitted for all labor, equipment and material necessary to produce and placement of Ultrathin Bonded Wearing Course (Type B material and construction shall be in accordance with ARDOT special provisions).
5. One unit price per ton mile will be submitted for delivery to the designated county road to be overlaid. Faulkner County will multiply the unit price bid for delivery by the actual miles to the center of the county road being overlaid and add that delivery rate to the unit price bid for labor, equipment, and material on the particular county road and this will be the unit price per ton the contractor will be paid for on that particular county road.
6. One unit price per ton will be submitted for ACHM Surface Course PG64-22 FOB plant.
7. One unit price per ton will be submitted for ACHM Binder Course PG64-22 FOB plant.

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Tack Coat (0.03-0.1 gal per square yard for paving on existing asphalt or concrete) conforming to SECTION 401 - Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2014 edition, as published by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department will be considered subsidiary to the amount bid for in-place asphalt and not paid for separately.
- Asphalt Binder and Mineral Aggregate used in the Asphalt Concrete Hot Mix Surface (1/2") and Asphalt Concrete Hot Mix Binder (1 and 1/4") shall be in accordance with Section 409 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2014 edition, as published by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. The asphalt binder shall be Performance Grade 64-22.
- The placement of the Asphalt Concrete Hot Mix Surface shall be in accordance with Section 410 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2014 edition, as published by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department.

- The placement of Ultrathin Bonded Wearing Course Type B material and construction shall be in accordance with ARDOT special provisions.
- All mix designs must be submitted to and approved by the County Judge or his designee.
- Asphalt mix designs containing Recycled Asphalt Pavement or Recycled Asphalt Shingles will not be accepted.
- All tax and fees will be considered to be included in the bid price submitted.
- Measurement of Asphalt Hot Mix Surface Courses acceptably placed and completed will be measured and paid for by the ton (Truck ticket).
- Failure to provide prompt delivery (delivery within 15 days of notification of need for in-place asphalt) may result in the county securing asphalt from other suppliers. It is anticipated that if the firm submitting the low bid is not available the County will go down the list of firms in order of \$ amount to find the next selected contractor.
- Unit prices must be for delivery and placement at destination as requested by Jim Baker, County Judge or his designee.
- No unit delivery fee will be charged if Faulkner County delivers the asphalt with County owned trucks.
- Bid Bond not required.
- Performance Bond not required.
