RESOLUTION NO. 24-02

RESOLUTION OF THE QUORUM COURT OF FAULKNER COUNTY TO ADVANCE EFFECTIVE, ACCOUNTABLE POLICING AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE PRACTICES TO ENHANCE PUBLIC TRUST AND PUBLIC SAFETY

Be it resolved by the Quorum Court of Faulkner County, State of Arkansas a resolution entitled: Advancing Effective, Accountable Policing and Criminal Justice Practices to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety.

WHEREAS, on May 25, 2022, Presidential Executive Order (EO) 14074 "Advancing Effective, Accountable Policing and Criminal Justice Practices to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety" was signed.

WHEREAS, in accordance with EO (Section 12), State, Tribal, Local, and Territorial Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAS) must:

- 1) Notify their Civilian Governing Body (CGB) (i.e., The Quorum Court) of its intent to request property from Federal sources to include Federal funds or grants.
- 2) Notify the Local Community of its request for property transfers, purchases from Federal funds, agencies, or subcontractors (including existing transfer contracts or grants).

WHEREAS, The Faulkner County Sheriff's Office may request controlled property items from the Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO), or other Federal sources as provided in the attached list set forth in Exhibit A, and the list included and incorporated as though set forth word for word herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Faulkner County Quorum Court that:


SECTION 1: Faulkner County Sheriff's Office will participate in accordance with EO 14074 (Section 12), State, Tribal, Local, and Territorial Law Enforcement Agencies.


SECTION 2: Faulkner County Judge, Allen Dodson, is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary for the Faulkner County Sheriff's Office to act in accordance with EO 14074.

SECTION 3: The Faulkner County Quorum Court pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Faulkner County Sheriff's Office to initiate action to implement the Executive Order.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall take effect immediately.
